## Boys Uniform Policy 2011-2012

The administration has final authority in all matters related to student appearance and reserves the right to request any changes deemed necessary.

All uniform items must be purchased from Dennis Uniform except shoes, socks, and belts.

### General Appearance

- \* Uniform shirts must be tucked in at all times while on campus or in the building (including before and after school).
- \* Student's clothing must be the correct size. Items that are too big or too small will have to be replaced.
- \* Clothing may not be dirty, torn, frayed, or have holes.
- \* Pants and shorts may not be excessively tight or baggy and must be worn at the waist. Shorts must not be shorter than the fingertips when arms are placed straight down at the sides.
- \* Tattoos are not permitted nor is writing or drawing upon the skin.
- \* Undergarments should not be visible at any time.
- \* Boys may not wear makeup or nail polish.
- \* Moderate jewelry or accessories are permitted but may not be feminine, gaudy, or showy.
- \* Piercings are not permitted
- \* Sunglasses, hats, head coverings, bandanas, or scarves are not permitted.
- \* Boys must be clean shaven. Sideburns are permitted but may not extend below the earlobe.

### Hair Styles

- \* Hair must be cut neat and clean. It must be cut above the ears, eyebrows, and collar.
- \* Hair may only be colored a natural color that blends with, or is close to the student's natural hair color.
- \* Hair may not be styled in an extreme manner, including the Mohawk/faux-hawk style.

### Daily Uniform

- \* Boys must wear a royal blue, white, or gold polo shirt with school logo, tucked in, with a solid black, khaki, or brown belt, and khaki pants or shorts.
- \* Long sleeved shirts may be worn under the polo in solid school colors-white, black, blue, or gold.
- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets are permitted in class

### Chapel Uniform

- \* Boys must wear the white button shirt with school logo, tucked in, an appropriate tie, a solid color black, khaki, or brown belt, and khaki pants.
- \* Only white long sleeved shirts may be worn under the chapel shirt.
- \* Shorts and hoodies may not be worn to chapel.
- \* Chapel attire is permitted on any day of the week.

### P.E. Uniform (7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade only)

- \* Dennis Uniform supplies the grey t-shirt, sweatshirt or hoodie with school logo and navy blue mesh shorts.
- \* P.E. uniforms must be worn correctly. Shorts may not be sagged and sleeves cannot be rolled up to shoulders.
- \* Solid color navy blue sweatpants may be worn in cold weather.
- \* Students must wear walking, running, or tennis shoes for P.E.

### Shoes and Socks

- \* Shoes may not be: skater style shoes, flip flops, sandals, Birkenstock style sandals, crocs, boots, house slippers, or have lights or wheels, All shoes must have a back. Mules or open back shoes are not permitted.
- \* Shoes may not have characters, pictures, or words on them, other than the brand logo.
- \* 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade boys must wear brown, grey, or black dress shoes with pants. Walking, running, or tennis shoes may be worn with shorts and must be mostly white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or brown.
- \* Elementary boys must wear walking, running, or tennis shoes that are mostly white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or brown.
- \* Socks must be colors white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or brown.

### Cold Weather Policy

- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets are permitted in class
- \* Neck scarves will be permitted in class during cold weather.
- \* Hats may not be worn in the building.

## Alternative Dress Days

On scheduled days students will have the opportunity to wear non-uniform clothing to school. This privilege may be revoked if abused. If it happens to be a chapel day and the student does not participate in the alternative dress day then the chapel uniform must be worn.

### -Free Dress Day

- \* Non-uniform clothing may be worn with the purchase of a \$2 wristband.
- \* Inappropriate or anti-Christian content will not be permitted.
- \* Free dress day is the only day non-uniform sweaters and jackets are permitted in class.
- \* Shorts/skorts must extend past the fingertips when arms are placed straight down at the sides.
- \* All pants or shorts must be worn at the waist and may not sag.
- \* Belts are not required.
- \* Shirts do not have to be tucked in; however, undergarments and midriffs should not be visible at any time.
- \* Shirts may not be sleeveless.
- \* Free dress day is the only day boots are permitted. 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade boys may also wear closed back sandals. Elementary boys may not wear sandals due to the risk of injury on the playground.
- \* All other guidelines under **General Appearance** must be followed.

### -Christian T-shirt Day (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> only)

- \* Students may wear Christian t-shirts with denim bottoms on the first Friday of every month (Sept. – May).
- \* Christian T-shirts must be clearly identifiable as Christian. They usually include a Bible verse, Christian message, or symbol such as a cross or Christian fish symbol.
- \* Handmade Christian shirts will not be permitted.
- \* Uniform polo shirts and ICS club shirts are acceptable on these days (not to include P.E. shirts).
- \* Musical groups are not permitted as Christian t-shirts.
- \* Shirts may not be sleeveless.
- \* Shirts do not have to be tucked in; however, undergarments and midriffs should not be visible at any time.
- \* Belts are not required.
- \* Pants and shorts must either be Dennis uniform items or blue or black denim only.
- \* Shorts must extend past the fingertips when arms are placed straight down at the sides.
- \* All other guidelines under **General Appearance** must be followed.
- \* Shoes - see the **Shoes and Socks** section on reverse.
- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets may be worn in class.

### -Club Shirt Day (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> only)

- \* Students in grades 7-12 may wear an ICS Club shirt with denim bottoms every Wednesday (excluding the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school).
- \* All ICS Club Shirts will be screen printed by David's Apparel or the uniform polo shirt may be worn.
- \* Handmade club shirts will not be permitted.
- \* Shirts do not have to be tucked in; however, undergarments and midriffs should not be visible at any time.
- \* Shirts may not be sleeveless.
- \* Pants and shorts must either be Dennis uniform items or blue or black denim only.
- \* Shorts must extend past the fingertips when arms are placed straight down at the sides.
- \* All other guidelines under **General Appearance** must be followed.
- \* Shoes - see the **Shoes and Socks** section on reverse.
- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets may be worn in class.

- \* **Inappropriate or anti Christian content on any clothing may result in disciplinary action and/or the possible loss of alternative dress day privileges.**

## Girls Uniform Policy 2011-2012

The administration has final authority in all matters related to student appearance and reserves the right to request any changes deemed necessary.

All uniform items must be purchased from Dennis Uniform except shoes, socks, and belts.

### General Appearance

- \* Modesty is the standard. Clothing that is form fitting or revealing is not permitted.
- \* Student's clothing must be the correct size. Items that are too big or too small will have to be replaced.
- \* Uniform shirts must be tucked in at all times while on campus or in the building (including before and after school).
- \* Clothing may not be dirty, torn, frayed, or have holes.
- \* Pants, skirts, skorts, and shorts may not be excessively tight or baggy and must be worn at the waist.
- \* Shorts and skorts must not be shorter than the fingertips when arms are placed straight down at the sides.
- \* Skirts must not be shorter than 3" above the bend of the knee. *No rolled waistbands.* Bike shorts must be worn underneath skirts for all girls up to the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade.
- \* Tattoos are not permitted nor is writing or drawing upon the skin.
- \* Undergarments should not be visible at any time.
- \* Only 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade girls may wear makeup and nail polish in moderation. Kinder-6<sup>th</sup> grade girls may only wear clear nail polish.
- \* Moderate jewelry or accessories are permitted but may not be excessive, gaudy, or showy.
- \* Up to two piercings per ear are permitted. Earrings may not be larger than one inch in diameter.
- \* Sunglasses, hats, head coverings, and bandanas are not permitted.

### Hair Styles

- \* Hair must be styled neat and clean.
- \* Hair may only be colored a natural color that blends with, or is close to the student's natural hair color.
- \* Hair may not be styled in an extreme manner or so that it cover the eyes.

### Daily Uniform

- \* Girls must wear a royal blue, white, or gold polo shirt with school logo, tucked in, with a solid color black, khaki, or brown belt, and khaki pants, shorts, skirt, skort, or the Mayfair plaid skirt or skort.
- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets are permitted in class
- \* Long sleeved shirts may be worn under the polo in solid school colors-white, black, blue, or gold.

### Chapel Uniform

- \* K4-6<sup>th</sup> grade girls must wear the white button shirt under the Mayfair plaid jumper and tie. K4-3<sup>rd</sup> must wear shorts underneath the jumper.
- \* Secondary girls must wear the Mayfair plaid chapel skirt with either
  - o The white oxford button shirt with school logo
  - o or the uniform cardigan, vest, or sweatshirt must be worn over the white button blouse without the school logo.
  - o Ties are not required for secondary girls.
- \* Only white long sleeved shirts may be worn under the chapel shirt.
- \* Hoodies may not be worn to chapel.
- \* Chapel attire is permitted on any day of the week.

### P.E. Uniform (7th – 12th grade only)

- \* Dennis Uniform supplies a grey t-shirt, sweatshirt, and hoodie with school logo and navy blue mesh shorts.
- \* P.E. uniforms must be worn correctly. Waistbands may not be rolled up and sleeves cannot be rolled up to shoulders.
- \* Solid color navy blue sweatpants may be worn in cold weather.
- \* Students must wear walking, running, or tennis shoes for P.E.

### Shoes and Socks

- \* Uniform shoes for **Elementary** girls should be walking, running, or tennis shoes that are mostly white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or brown.
- \* 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade girls must wear brown, grey, or black dress shoes. However, walking, running, or tennis shoes may be worn with shorts and skorts and must be mostly white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or brown.
- \* Shoes **may not be:** skater style shoes, flip flops, sandals, Birkenstock style sandals, crocs, boots, house slippers, or have lights or wheels, All shoes must have a back. Mules or open back shoes are not permitted.
- \* Shoes may not have characters, pictures, or words on them.
- \* Heels may not be more than two inches (2") high.
- \* **Socks**, hosiery, or tights must be colors white, khaki, black, grey, navy, or skin tones. Footless leggings are not permitted.

## Cold Weather Policy

- \* Only uniform sweaters and jackets are permitted in class
- \* Neck scarves will be permitted in class during cold weather.
- \* Hats may not be worn in the building.

## Alternative Dress Days

On scheduled days students will have the opportunity to wear non-uniform clothing to school. This privilege may be revoked if abused. If it happens to be a chapel day and the student does not participate in the alternative dress day then the chapel uniform must be worn.

### -Free Dress Day
